

## **Discipleship Nights Schedule: Fall 2011**

September 14<sup>th</sup>: **“No One is Father as God is Father”**

*Who is God? How did He create the world? Does He really love me as a Father?*

September 21<sup>st</sup>: **“It Is Not Good for Man to Be Alone”**

*Why did God create Adam? Why did He create me? What can Adam’s solitude teach me about finding God in my own loneliness?*

September 28<sup>th</sup>: **“This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh”**

*What is love? Why do we need it? Why is a “communion of persons” better than a “community”?*

October 5<sup>th</sup>: **“Naked and Not Ashamed”**

*Why did God create us as male and female? How do our bodies become ‘gift’ to each other? How could Adam and Eve be ‘naked and not ashamed’?*

October 12<sup>th</sup>: **“A Fundamental Disquiet in All Human Existence”**

*What is sin? How does it affect my relationship with God? Why was the sin of Adam and Eve such a big deal?*

October 19<sup>th</sup>: **Hardness of Heart: Historical Man in the Old Testament**

*Why do the people in the Old Testament do so many un-Christian things?*

October 26<sup>th</sup>: **The Way to Redemption: God Chooses His People**

*What does it mean that God “chose” the people of Israel?*

November 2<sup>nd</sup>: All Souls Day – no Discipleship Night

November 9<sup>th</sup>: **“Thou Shalt Love the Lord your God . . .”**

*Why is the “greatest commandment” to love God? How does that work in my life?*

November 16<sup>th</sup>: **“Love your Neighbor as Yourself”**

*Who is my neighbor? How do the commandments say I should love him or her? What does “coveting” have to do with love?*

November 23<sup>rd</sup>: Thanksgiving – no Discipleship Night

November 30<sup>th</sup>: **Mary, Mother of the Redeemer**

*How could Mary be sinless? Why did John Paul II say “To honor Mary is to go to Jesus”? What’s the difference between honoring Mary and worshipping her?*

December 7<sup>th</sup>: **Mary and the “Feminine Genius”**

*What is the “feminine genius”? How was Mary both virgin and mother? Why is Mary the “new beginning of the dignity and vocation of women”?*

December 14<sup>th</sup>: **“And the Word was Made Flesh”**

*Why do we need a Savior? What is He saving us from? Who is He in our lives?*
