

EMERGENCY FOOD DRIVE TO SUPPORT ST. MARY PARISH PANTRY

WHEN? Saturday March 28 – 10:00 AM to 2:00 PM
Sunday March 29 – 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM

WHERE? St. Mary Catholic Parish – Marian Hall (lower level of church building)

HOW? Bring food to Marian Hall, at the double doors on the north side of the building.
Volunteers will receive the food directly from your vehicle, to minimize person-to-person contact.

WHY? Twice each year, American Heritage Girls at St. Mary Parish partner with the food pantry, by organizing a food drive at a local King Soopers store. The Easter food drive was scheduled for this weekend, but was cancelled due to the Coronavirus health crisis.

The food pantry ministry continues to distribute food during scheduled hours. Food donations are drastically down since all public Masses are cancelled and St. Mary Catholic School is temporarily closed. With the cancellation of the AHG food drive, we will empty our pantry shelves at a time when the needs of our community continue to increase.
