Confirmation Peer Leader Confirmation Classes (Grades 6-12)

Position Title: Confirmation Peer Leader (Youth Grades 7-12 who have already received the Sacrament of Confirmation)

Reports to: Middle School Youth Minister, Laura Potter and Dc. Tim Kilbarger

Scheduled shift: Sunday 10:30am-12:30pm (after 9:30am Mass)

Length of Commitment: 1 year (September-May), renew term commitment after that

Job location: Youth Room (Near School Gym)

Position duties:

- Faithfully Attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation
- Commit to a "Rule of Life" (Relationship with God/Daily Prayer, Relationship with Family, Mission to Nazareth Youth & Families, Living Vocation)
- Lead Small Group with Adult Small Group Leader
- Relational Ministry with co-leaders, Confirmation students, and parents
- Lead through example
- Confirmation class preparation and Team Collaboration
- Behind the scenes work

Details of Position:

- Relational Ministry: Building relationships with co-leaders and Confirmation students, sharing Jesus by how you relate to them
- Lead through example: interceding, listening, encouraging, loving each youth where he or she is at and leading them closer to Jesus through being yourself
- Lead Small Group with Adult Small Group Leader: Using Decision Point Curriculum by Matthew Kelly, leading small group in lesson discussion to help them take what they're learning and apply it to their daily lives
- Attend leader trainings to collaborate with Adult co-leaders
- Help with behind the scenes work
- Dress appropriately for leading parish children and families (modest, comfortable, neat and presentable).
- Sign up for and assist with retreats and trainings as needed, including helping with setup, refreshments and cleanup.

- Confirmation Peer Leaders are expected to represent the church, parish and DCJM well, and demonstrate good ministry skills by being polite, patient, encouraging and engaging with the program children, families and other ministry leaders.
